Pray for the unreached Japanese city of Minamikyuushuu

As long as there are millions destitute of the Word of God and knowledge of Jesus Christ, it is impossible for our hearts to be settled in merely devoting time and energy to those who have both. While yes, we enjoy ministering to churches here in the USA in the process of getting to Japan, that is not the desire of our hearts. Our desire is to be the light of Christ in the darkness among the unreached people of Japan. Perhaps the darkest places in Japan are those towns and cities that have no Christian churches. In this newsletter I'd like to highlight just one of the many cities in Japan with no churches that God has laid on our heart over the past two months. Minamikyuushuu is a city in southern Japan known for its samurai quarter, where Japanese warriors lived during the 17th century. Nearly 40,000 people live there today with no Christian

church. The closest Christian church is a small evangelical church 30 minutes away by car, and is the only church in that neighboring city. This poses a great opportunity to bring the glorious good news of the death and resurrection of Christ for salvation to a city that is basically unreached. However, this area is uniquely challenging because the dialect of Japanese native to this area is vastly different than mainstream Japanese. Pray that God would send a missionary to this city to evangelize, make disciples, and plant a church among these people who are very precious to God.

God has been good to us and given us much grace during the past year. As we start our second year, please pray for our perseverance on deputation,
